Seglamen is located in the Tigray region of Africa, where the climate is very dry and ground covered with rocks. With its arid conditions and extremely low water table, access to clean water is challenging and essential.



2011 Campaign




The May Tsebri well represents one of several water projects in the larger community of Seglamen, Tigray

Once all the projects are completed, over 28,000 community members will have access to clean water.


As always, the community around the well has received training on the importance of hygiene and sanitation.

They have also been trained on how to care for the well and a committee responsible for its maintenance has been elected.

Changing Lives



Due to poor hygiene and sanitation practices in Seglamen, infant mortality has been very high, and many community members have suffered from water-borne diseases or intenstinal worms transmitted through dirty water. The completion of the May Tsebri well represents an important step towards better health in the community.
